**Diversity:** The membership of the IES includes lighting designers, electrical engineers, energy engineers, consulting engineers, interior designers, architects, government and utility personnel, electrical distributors, contractors and wholesalers, facility and plant managers, building owners, manufacturers and manufacturer representatives, testing laboratories, construction specifiers, researchers, educators, students and associated lighting professionals.

#### **Associate Grade:** Annual Dues \$170

Shall be interested in the mission of the Society and be at least eighteen years of age. An Associate is entitled to all current privileges and benefits, but shall not serve on the Board of Directors, as District Chair or as a Committee Chairperson.

# Emerging Professional – Associate Grade: Annual Dues \$75

A limited Associate Grade for the emerging professional (EP) just entering the lighting field or a recent college graduate. Candidate must qualify for this reduced dues. All current privileges and benefits for Associate Grade apply.

## Member Grade: Annual Dues \$170

Requirements include graduation from an accredited four-year program with a degree in the art or science of illumination. In addition, the applicant should be actively engaged for at least five years (with LC, four years) in a professional capacity in a field related to illumination. Or Have made some valuable contribution to the art or science of illuminating engineering or to its literature. Or Be actively engaged for at least ten years (with LC, eight years) in the practice or teaching of illumination or directly related fields.

## **Associate or Member Grade Options**

## **Individual Subscriber:** Annual Dues \$550 (First year) \$350 (subsequent or renewal year)

IES offers individual members, in addition to all member benefits, the opportunity to receive print copies of the entire IES Lighting Library (over 60 publications) and the IES Lighting Handbook. Subsequent library updates are sent to the member as long as this membership is maintained.

# **Individual Sponsor:** Annual Dues \$250

#### **Student Grade:** Annual Dues \$20

Shall be registered as a full-time student in a college or university for study toward a degree in engineering, science, fine arts, architecture, interior design or other related fields or enrolled full-time in an accredited two-year technical school whose curriculum is related to illumination. A student member shall be entitled to all current privileges and benefits, but shall not have the right to vote or to hold elective office.

## **Sustaining Membership:** Annual Dues range from \$700 - \$25,000

Individuals, institutions, and companies may elect Sustaining Membership. The additional support from Sustaining Members contributes to the technical, educational and research efforts of the Society.
